

Joh 18:5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.

The men came to arrest Jesus. The verse says "And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them" (John 18:5). What a shame! Judas chose to stand with those who came to arrest Jesus.

Judas was chosen and ordained as one of the twelve disciples and also as an apostle (Matt 10:1-5). But he failed to continue in the way of righteousness. He was covetous and also a thief (John 12:4-6). Jesus spoke prophetically of Judas' act, calling him a devil and the son of perdition (John 6:70-71; 17:12). What a name to be called. He could be a son of God, but he chose to be the son of perdition (meaning, destruction), a child of the devil.

He was called the "son of perdition" (John 17:12) because he chose the path that led to destruction. He was called a "devil" (John 6:70) because he chose the way of darkness. He wilfully chose the wages of unrighteousness, preferring thirty pieces of silver than his Lord and Saviour. He had no qualms about selling his Lord for just the price of a slave. Indeed, thirty pieces of silver was the price of a slave (Exo 21:32).

He felt no qualms of conscience when he kissed his Master, which was a signal to the waiting armies that here was the One whom they sought. There was no affection in that kiss. It was a kiss of betrayal. It was a kiss that sealed his destiny as a son of perdition.

The point I would like to note this morning is that Judas stood with them that came to arrest Jesus. He was not on the side of Jesus. How about us? Whose side are we standing on?

The Psalmist wrote: "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful" (Psa 1:1).

Notice the three actions – Walk, Stand, and Sit. The Ungodly man walks, the Sinner stands, and the Scornful man sit down in the way of iniquity. The ungodly man walks after his own counsels; he does not want God in his life. The sinner chooses to stand with the sinners; he is unconcerned about righteousness. The scornful despises God and sin; he ridicules God and sin.

Judas chose the way of unrighteousness. He chose to stand with the sinners. He chose the path of destruction. Unfortunately, some Christians choose the same path as Judas – the path that leads to destruction.


Those who choose sin choose the path that ends in destruction. Like Judas, they become the sons of perdition. Paul gave warning to those who love covetousness that they are falling into the same temptation that destroyed Judas: "But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition" (1 Tim 6:9).

After Paul had given a list on the works of the flesh, his conclusion was this: "they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God" (Gal 5:21). Their path is the path of destruction; they will not have eternal life waiting for them.

Whose side are you standing? Are you standing with Jesus or with the sinners? To stand with Jesus is to choose eternal life (John 14:6). To stand with sinners is to

choose eternal damnation (Rom 6:23). Everyone has a choice - choose life or death. "I call heaven and earth record this against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and therefore cursing: choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live" (Deut 30:19).

Let us stand with Jesus and live eternally with Him in heaven.





Moses' Excuses, God's Answers

God told Moses He wanted to send him to deliver His people. He responded, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?" God took away the excuse by promising to be with him. **Anyone is someone with Almighty God on his side** (Exodus 3:9-12; Romans 8:31).

Moses asked who he should say had sent him. God said to say, "I Am has sent me," or the One who exists by His Own power (Exodus 3:13-14; Revelation 1:4)! Moses was to tell the Israelite elders that God had seen their suffering, would deliver them and take them to the promised land. Moses and the elders were to ask Pharaoh to let them go three days' journey into the wilderness to worship their God. He foretold that Pharaoh would not let them go, even by a powerful hand. The Almighty would send them out with abundance as if Egypt had been plundered (Exodus 3:13-22; Genesis 15:14)!

Moses said the people would not believe him. God gave him three miracles designed to convince the elders that he was God's chosen messenger. His rod would become a serpent and turn back into a rod. His hand would be leprous and then whole again. Water from the river would turn to blood when poured out on the ground (Exodus 4:1-9).

Moses next said he was not an eloquent public speaker, either before God began speaking or at that very moment. This excuse borders on being an accusation against God. It is tacitly false, as Deuteronomy demonstrates. God did not remedy this supposed problem, but He said He had made man's mouth and could strengthen Moses (Exodus 4:10-12).

Moses finally asked God to send anyone but him. God was angry because He had promised all necessary aid. He gave to Moses his brother Aaron as his mouthpiece. The ultimate power would come from God as He gave Moses the words to speak (Exodus 4:13-17).

The futility of making excuses to God is evident. He made us. He knows us. He will not ask us to do anything we are unable to do.


